## THE FAR RIGHT WINNER OF THE EUROPEAN ELECTIONS AHEAD OF LREM WITH 23, 6%

### JORDAN BARDELLA THE YOUNGEST LEADER

**USPA NEWS** - RN Le Rassemblement National, from Le Droit Droite (Marine Le Pen, whose list leader, the young Jordan Bardella, won the European election, with a score of 23.4% of 1 point ahead of the presidential majority party. Emmanuel Macron, LREM (The Republic in March), represented by Nathalie Loiseau, who made 22.4% followed by Yves Jadot, of Europe Ecology Greens.

The Right had a low score of 8.3% led by leader Francois Xavier Bellamy, and the socialist left PS, led by Raphael Glucksman who won 6.8%. Voter turnout was exceptionally strong at 51.3% versus 42.43% in 2014. Marine Le Pen, took advantage of its victory ("The Victory of the People" the slogan of the RN) to demand the dissolution of the National Assembly. It should be noted that a majority of Overseas Territories for the first time placed the National Gathering at the head of an election. The department of Mayotte even offers him his best score at the national level in the European elections. ### GREEN ECOLOGIST EUROPEANS HELD BY YANNICK JADOT MAKE A HIGH SCORE WITH 13.2% BEFORE SOCIALISTS

"A European green wave". Thus Yannick Jadot, head of the list of Europe Ecology Greens (EELV), welcomed the third place on the list in the European elections with the score of 13.2% of the votes, won between 12 to 14 seats, double their current 6 seats. The party ecologist makes a score more than hopes because it exceeds the major traditional parties, (socialists and Republicans) and before the Great European Party, because there is a great green breakthrough this Sunday in other European countries: in Germany , ecologists come second, in Ireland they made a historical breakthrough.

### THE VICTORY OF RN CONFIRMS THE SUCCESS OF THE CAMPAIGN TAKEN BY YOUNG JORDAN BARDELLA

The choice of the young Jordan Bardella (Regional Councilor in Ile de France) by Marine Le Pen entrusted him with the mission of leading the list of his European election campaign, was a success. and this victory of the RN reinforces Marine's strategy. The party of the RN would win between 23 to 25 seats in the European Parliament, among the 74 French sweatshings in the Parliament consists of 750 MEPs. The second LREM party wins 20 to 24 of its members in the European Parliament

**LREM THE PRESIDENTIAL LIST CONDUCTED BY NATHALIE LOISEAU MAKES 22.4% BEHIND THE RN**

Behind the RN, with around 22.4% of the votes cast at the top of the list The Republic on the Move (LREM), Nathalie Loiseau, former Minister of European Affairs, failed to beat the RN, facing her opponent the young Jordan Bardera. Prime Minister Edouard Philippe said declared "When one finishes second, one can not say that one has won", and "regrets the rooting of the extreme right to the point of becoming a great force" political in France. Despite this defeat of the majority, the entourage of Emmanuel Macron ensures that there will be "no change of course". "The fight is not over," said Nathalie Loiseau, "we will take him to the European Parliament to prevent the nationalists from blocking France."

**REPUBLICANS MAKE A DECEIVING SCORE WITH ONLY 8.2%-----**

The Party of the Right French, LR, The Republicans, led by Jean Francois Xavier Bellamy, the young professor of philosophy made a disappointing score with only 8.2% of votes which corresponds to the worst score in a national election. Republicans would have only 8 to 9 seats of European deputies instead of the current 20 seats.-----

**THE LEFT SOCIALIST AND FAR LEFT MAKE WEAK SCORE-----**

The Socialist Party of Olivier Faure, also made a low score, down the list lead led by Raphael Gluksman, a writer, getting only 6.4% and would win 6 to 7 seats in the European Parliament. This is also the case for the extreme left of LFI France Insoumise, the party of Jean Luc Melenchon, led by Manon Aubry, former activist, getting only 6.4% and would win 6 to 7 European Parliament. A great deception for the French Left wing and far extreme left as well. There is therefore a new political landscape that has been redrawn following results that are not in line with projections based on anticipated polls, in a period in France where the social and governance crisis has been going on for six months, since the first manifestation of the Yellow Vests, November 17th.
