including on the security forces, both in Istanbul and in the south-east provinces, as well as on the United States´ Consulate in Istanbul. He is greatly concerned by the violence. The Secretary-General expresses his deepest sympathies with the victims of today´s acts, as well as with the Government and people of Turkey. He hopes that the perpetrators of the attacks will be swiftly brought to justice.

News reported events in Turkey:

The far-leftist Revolutionary People's Liberation Army-Front (DHKP/C) claimed responsibility for the attack on the US consulate. One of the assailants, a female who was wounded during the shoot-out with police, was later captured nearby. The second attacker, also a woman, escaped from the area.

In 2013, the DHKP/C claimed responsibility for an attack on the US embassy in the capital, Ankara, that killed a Turkish security guard.

"The group is known for its anti-American and anti-US stance," Lale Sariibrahimoglu, a military analyst, said.
