"Our duty is to find sustainable solutions, based on values: humanity, responsibility, firmness," said the Prime Minister Manuel Valls quoted a phrase inscribed on the pedestal of the Statue of Liberty in New York: "Give me your poor, your exhausted which, in serried ranks, yearning to breathe free, the refuse of your teeming shore, send me these disinherited rejected by storm. From my light, I light the golden door."

He called in contrast to the "hard" against illegal economic migration. Manuel Valls also make a trip to Calais Monday with Bernard Cazeneuve, Minister of the Interior, and two Commissioners.
