## **PRESIDENT OBAMA IS DETERMINED TO COMBAT ISIL IN SYRIA BUT BACHAR AL ASSAD**

**USPA NEWS** - The President Obama affirmed his clear and firm position to fight Islamic state in Syria and Bashar Al Assad must go, in his address to the UN. Vladimir Poutine continues to want to maintain Bashar Al Assad in power to fight together against ISIL.

USA MAINTAINS A POSITION "ANTI BACHAR" AND FIGHTING AGAINST ISIL TO STABILISE SYRIA

US Army has conducted over the past year more than 5,000 air strikes against positions of "Islamic State" in Iraq and Syria. When anti terrorist summit on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly, received one hundred countries invited by the US, which Russia wished not to attend.

President Obama said that "In Syria, defeating the ISIL requires a new leader" by replacing Assad. The President Obama remains faithful to what he had said the day before the General Assembly of the UN.

The President Vladimir Putin met Obama for 1 hour and a half. They had not discussed since 2013.

After the air strikes of the coalition, Obama spoke of military successes against the ISIL in northern Syria, near the border with Turkey, and the "liberation of Tikrit" in Iraq. Last year, President Obama has presided over a session of the Security Council devoted to these young foreigners, including many Westerners, indoctrinated and recruited into the ranks of the ISIL.

THE POSITION OF RUSSIA IS ALWAYS WITH AN UNWAVERING SUPPORT FOR BASHAR AL ASSAD ALTHOUGH DETERMINED TO FIGHT AGAINST ISIL IN SYRIA-----

Russia was invited to the summit, but not Iran, that helps yet Iraq and Syria to fight the ISIL. Obama welcomed Nigeria attacked by the Islamist group Boko Haram, Tunisia and Malaysia in the coalition that has about sixty countries, including Canada, the United Kingdom, France and the Arab neighbours of Syria.

The President Obama has said that the refusal of the US to attack Syria is a "political decision". This implies a strategy, corroborated by alliances built and legitimise a military strike without having prepared the political transition of the country. The numbers of victims counted officially 250,000, well below the reality.

The only problem is that it is urgent to act because not only this Syrian conflict has bogged down for too long (Debut 2011) and henceforth majority of the Syrians are fleeing their country to the gates of Europe, wandering in exile towards a land of welcome and asylum politique. Europe is "saturated" and seems overtaken by this phenomenon and so complex to manage, trying to find the balance between "Humanity" and "Firmness".

It seems that Poutine and Obama exchanged during this long discussion and expressed in both, their differences, but their focal point, has enabled them for reaching agreement on a tactical cooperation between their respective armies that operate both now in Syria. The President Obama said that Putin keeps his promises.-----

The President Poutine confirmed to have sent aircrafts to strategic points in bases in Syria, to bring reinforcements to the Syrian Army. Vladimir Poutine, therefore takes back a central place in the heart of the conflict for the sake of the stabilisation process in Syria-----

In Russia, \$ 75 Billion (20% of GDP) represent the share in the military budget, which makes Russia, credible materially deployed already in the Mediterranean sea, which is close to Syria. Along the Bosphorus (Turquie) countless material expenses boats pass to Tartous combined to 28 Russian fighter jets in a base. "We provide and we will continue to provide technical and military assistance to Syria. We will not deploy on ground for now, since August 2015. "A declared Vladimir Poutine.--Since Syria of young Russian soldiers (about 17,000) were deployed in the country at the service of diplomacy"/
