MEETING OF SEGOLENE ROYAL WITH EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT AL SISSI -----

"The aim of this official meeting is to advance the renewable energy project in Africa. Egypt is my first step of an African tour as President of the COP, because Africa suffers from climate change include drought, soil degradation, salinisation of land, coastal erosion, deforestation, climate migration. Africa is not responsible for these disasters, but it suffers. Climate justice therefore requires a determined and effective implementation of the action decided by the summit of African leaders at the COP21. In a fascinating interview, the President of the Republic of Egypt Abdel Fattah al-Sissi, Chairman of the Committee of African Heads of State on Climate Change (CAHOSCC) told me of his commitment to the climate in Africa and its largest photovoltaic power plant project in Egypt.-----

We decided to work on a first progress report for presentation on April 22 at the United Nations. We found that the short time called a strong, simplified methods mobilisation. I offered to support coordination with the African Development Bank tomorrow I encounter in Abidjan and the African Union that I met today in Addis Ababa.-----
