WHAT IS A A ENFORCEMENT RESTAURANT ?-----

An "Enforcement restaurant"^[7], is attached to the Educational Units Day Activities (UEAJ), and serves a pedagogical purpose. In a dedicated and compliant space, this activity allows young people under judicial protection to acquire professional knowledge but above all to put in a real situation and thus incorporate appropriate postures of the trades of the kitchen and dining room. There are 24 enforcement restaurants in the gourmet guide PJJ.

OPENING EVENT HOSTED GUESTS AND TEN TASTING BOOTHS MANAGED BY 30 YOUNGSTERS UNDER JUDICIAL PROTECTION-----

During the Opening of the event the guests: 10 tasting booths manned by thirty young people under judicial protection, supported in educational units of daytime activities (UEAJ), and educational staff. In the presence of Catherine Sultan, Director of Judicial Protection of Youth, and Thierry Marx, the great chef.-----

Jean-Jacques Urvoas, the French Minister of Justice, has enjoyed visiting the stands and exchanged with youngsters and cook professionals, and staff.-----

Thierry Marx, chef two star Michelin engages in the operation initiated by the Ministry of Justice in giving of his time and of transmitting his knowledge, renames, the service youth under court protection. A gesture has both class and recalling that Thierry Marx grew between Belleville and Menilmontant neighbourhoods of Paris, that of Edith Piaf also illustrates another Parisian. Thierry Marx, who was passionate by cooking, and wanted become a baker, was found in the very young enlisted military service, hand in the Lebanon war of 1980 and becomes even peacekeeper before joining the Lebanese phalanges. Back in France, he fumbled among several physical as trades that money transporter, before returning to his primary passion: cooking and pastry. Maybe this was why Thierry Marx chose to engage with young offenders for their judicial protection (Minor) hoping to spare them from getting lost when the vocation is absent without a goal to achieve. It is seen as a kind of coaching, thanks to the Justice Minister Jean-Jacques Urvoas who welcomed this fruitful exchange of Thierry Marx (Jury in the very famous Top Chef issuance to the French TV M6 for 5 seasons) that arouses fascination by his talent of chef and his grand course for the youth.
