Our bilateral trade is steadily increasing and is expected to touch one billion US dollars in the next few years. The President said Côte d'Ivoire and India share common concerns in fight against international terrorism. We have been coordinating closely in regional and multilateral fora on this and other key issues including disarmament, climate change and sustainable development.

We both recognize the imperatives of strengthening the UN system and other international organizations. We would like to see them reformed so that they remain relevant and effective in addressing the challenges that confront the world today.
