“India Has Taken The Lead And The World Must Follow”

Mr. Prakash Javadekar, Union Minister of Human Resource Development, stressed on developing sustainable practices among students as part of long term plan for climate change mitigation. The minister was delivering the inaugural address at the National Conference on “Post-Paris Climate Change Action” in New Delhi on July 12, in which he reiterated the important role played by India under Prime Minister’s leadership, without which consensus was impossible in Paris Agreement.

He identified the role of HRD to make students aware and environmentally sensitive by adopting sustainable practices and low carbon lifestyle. HRD will emphasis this aspect in contributing towards fulfilling the promises made in the Paris agreement, he added.

He lauded the visionary dynamic leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in upscaling our renewable targets which changed the narrative of India’s negotiation in climate change discussions. Instead of a style of opposing the terms, we set out to propose alternative formulations and India has led from the front, he added.
